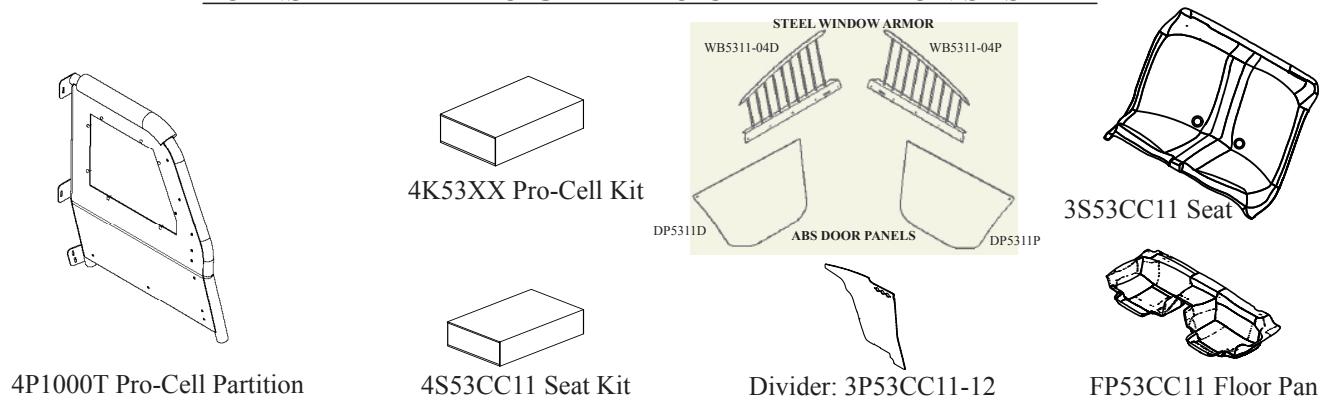

TO INSTALL THE PRO-GARD PRO-CELL PARTITION SYSTEM



I. Refer to the diagram on the last page of these instructions to verify all parts were received.

II. The following tools will be required to complete the installation.

- A. 1/4" drive ratchet with 7/16" socket
- B. 3/16" Allen key
- C. 1" Hole saw
- D. Drill with 3/8" Socket
- E. T15 Torx Driver

III. Read all instructions carefully before starting the assembly process.

NOTE: Locate all Wiring, Fuel Lines, Brake Lines, and/or Cooling Lines before drilling holes or installing Fasteners.

IV. B-Pillar Bracket Installation

A. Remove Center B-pillar trim on the Passenger-side.
This will be reinstalled after bracket installation. (See Fig. 1)

B. Place the Passenger B-pillar bracket (3P5314-03)
against the B-pillar face. (See Fig. 2).

C. Orient the B-pillar bracket so the bottom tab fits into the slot on the B-pillar and the formed edges wrap around the B-pillar. Push up on the Bracket until the tab is at the top of the slot. Using the supplied Self-Drilling screws (3X162) secure the B-pillar bracket to the vehicle b-pillar. (See Fig. 2)

NOTE: It is critical that the seat belt strap be on the outside of the B-pillar bracket (See Fig. 3)

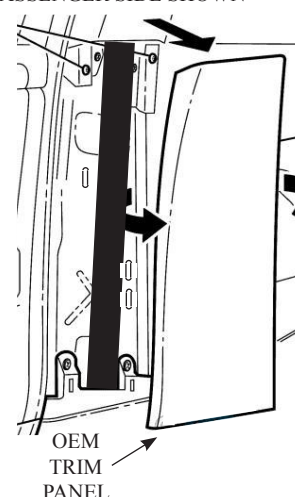

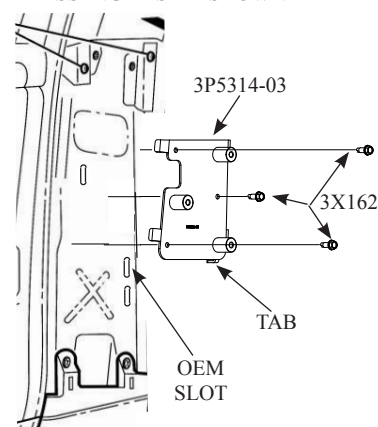
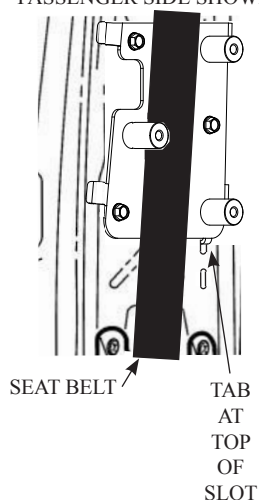


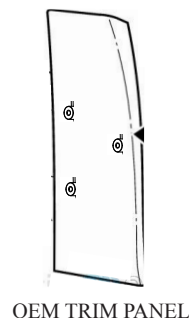

V. Drilling B-pillar Trim Panels

- A. Carefully align the template per its included instructions. Using a 1" Hole Saw drill the clearance holes as marked on the template. Replacement of sound insulation is optional.
- B. Replace the trim panel, insuring that the standoff's protrude through the panel. (See Fig. 4)

VI. Installation of Transport Seat and Floor Pan

A. Removing the OEM Seat

1. Begin by lifting the front of the lower seat cushion out from the plastic snaps in the floor. Once the seat is free, remove it from the vehicle (See Fig. 6).
2. Remove the seat belts by removing the two 17mm OEM nuts from their mounting studs. Do not remove the shoulder straps anchored at each side of the vehicle.
3. Remove the OEM seat back cushion by removing four 17mm nuts from the lower mounting brackets near the seat belt mounting studs.
4. Also remove the remaining two 13mm nuts holding lower child restraint brackets (3 pcs) and remove the brackets from the vehicle. (Fig. 5) Or bend the brackets down.

Note: This is necessary for the Pro-gard Seat to fit properly in position.

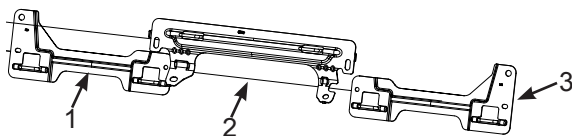
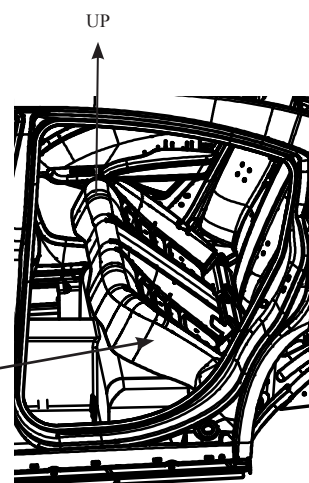

DRIVER SIDE SHOWN

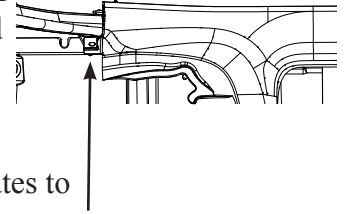
REAR SEAT

B. Removing the OEM Trim Panels

Fig. 7 Driver Side Scuff Panel

1. Remove the T15 Torx screw from the rear tab of the Rear Door Scuff Plates and then remove the Rear Door Scuff Plates on the Driver and Passenger-side. These will be reinstalled after the ABS Floor Pan Installation. (See Fig. 7)



2. Remove the upper seat transition trim that extends from the scuff plates to the small window near the outer shoulder harnesses on both the Driver and Passenger sides of the vehicle. (See Fig. 8)

3. Remove Center B-Pillar trim Panel. Then remove the B-Pillar lower transition trim panel on the passenger side of the vehicle.

C. Installing the ABS Floor Pan

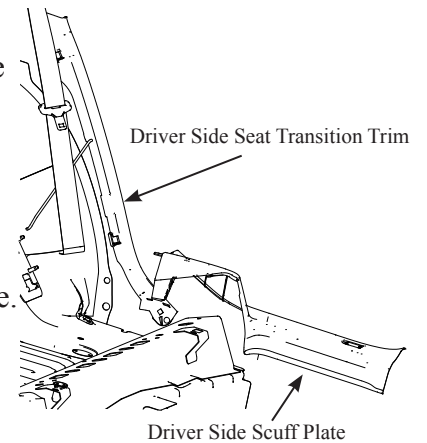

1. Place the ABS Floor Pan in the vehicle, making sure that there are no objects underneath of it. Insure that the Floor Pan is all the way back and down against the rear seat area.

Note: The floor pan does not cover the OEM seat grommets.

2. Reinstall the B-Pillar lower transition panels (Fig. 9) and the OEM Rear Door Scuff Plates on the Driver and Passenger-side.

Note: The Side Scuff Plates and the B-Pillar Transition Trim go on top of the ABS Floor Pan.



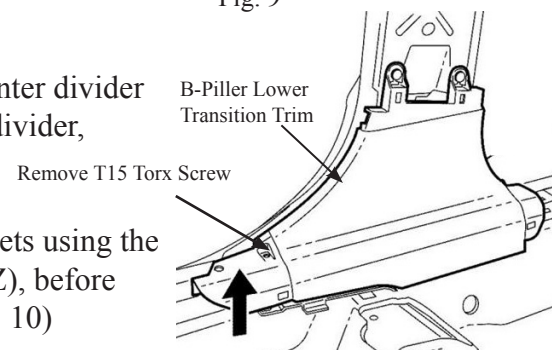
D. Installing the ABS Transport Seat

1. Preparing Transport Seat for installation:

- a. If installing a Pro-Gard Pro-Cell Kit with center divider then, go to Step b. If not installing a center divider, skip to Step 2.

- b. Attach the (3P214) Divider Mounting Brackets using the supplied bolts (3X36) and whiz nuts (3X16Z), before installing the seat in to the vehicle. (See Fig. 10)

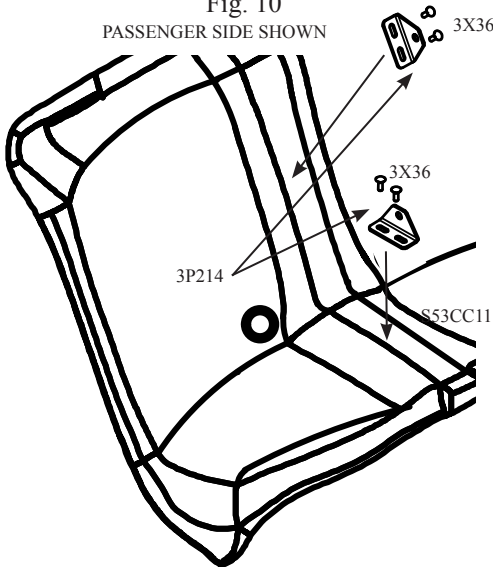

Note: The flat side of the bracket should face the driver's side; the divider will mount above the angled portion and flat against the bracket from the passenger side.

2. Place the seat in the vehicle. Make sure the seat is tucked behind the outer shoulder straps and is flush against the frame of the seat back. The seat will overlap the back edge of the floor pan. The upper trimmed edge of the seat should be flush with the top of the rear deck.

3. Be sure the seat belts are on the outside of the seat and operate freely.

Note: The gas tank is under the rear seat in this vehicle. Use pre-drilled locations and supplied hardware only!

Caution: Locate all Wiring, Fuel Lines, Brake Lines, and/or Cooling, Lines before drilling holes or installing fasteners.

4. Starting at the top of the transport seat along the edge near the rear deck. Fasten with four 1-1/2" long (3X77) self-tapping screws and (3X78) finish washers through the surface on the seat where the raised Pro-Gard lettering is seen. Be sure the upper trimmed edge of the seat is flush with the top edge of the rear deck.
5. Using four more 1-1/2" long (3X77) self-tapping screws and (3X78) finish washers, secure the front lower portion of the seat to the seat frame of the vehicle through the four recessed screw mounting locations.

E. Installing the OEM Seatbelts and ABS Cover Plates.

1. Insert the passenger side belt buckle through the passenger side seat cover plate (The plate with the smaller hole). Insert into the side with the rough surface and pass the bracket through the plate also. Slide the plate up the seat belt to allow access to bolt the buckle to the stud under the seat.
2. Insert the seat belts and buckles through the holes in the seat and reattach to OEM mounting studs with OEM nuts.
3. Slide cover plate assemblies over the buckles into the recesses in the seat. Orient and secure each cover plate using the four (3X72) Phillips truss head screws. (Fig. 11)

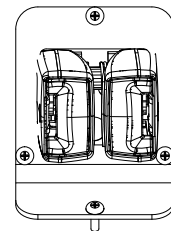
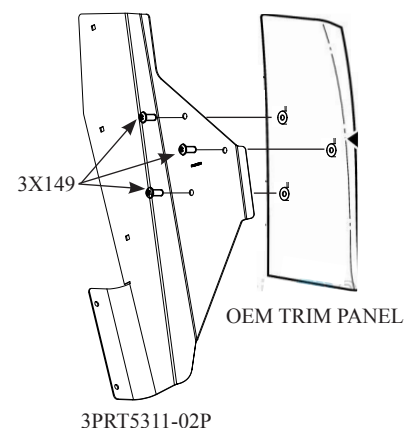

VII. Installing Partition Mounting Plate

- A. Attach the Passenger-side Mounting Plate (3PRT5311-02P) using the supplied 5/16-18 x 3/4" Button head screws (3X149) to the Standoff's protruding through the B-pillar trim (See Fig. 12). Hand tighten only for now.



VIII. Partition Bridge Bracket Installation

- A. Remove the two 17mm rear seat bolts where the Bridge Bracket (3PK5314-05) will bolt to (See Fig. 13). Lift the rear seat frame up and slide the bracket underneath the frame at the locations where the bolts were removed. Position the bracket so the bolts may be reinstalled.

Note: *It may be necessary to trim the front edge of the floor pan where the legs of the bracket overlap it. If so cut a small 1/2" deep V-notch at the point of overlap.*

- B. Re-install bolts and slide bracket towards front of vehicle against the bolts. Then tighten the bolts back down.
- C. Install adapter bracket (3PRT5311-10) using two carriage bolts (3X36) and two nuts (3X16Z). Hand tighten only for now.

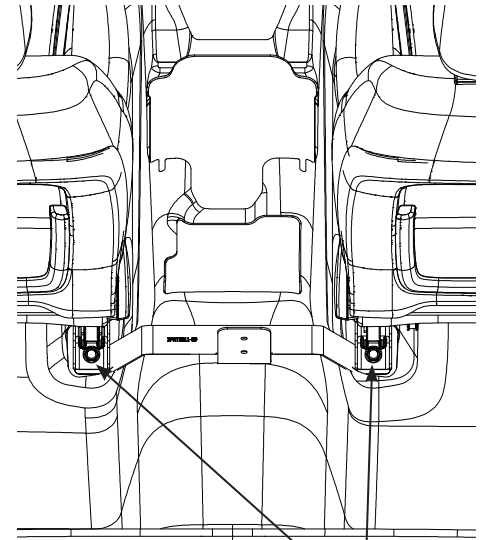

Remove bolts from seat frame, then slide bracket under seat frame.

IX. Pro-Cell Partition Installation

- A. Due to the weight and size of the partition, assistance from another party is highly recommended. Insert the partition into the vehicle, lift and position the partition so that it aligns with the Partition Mounting Plates, using the supplied 1/4-20 x 5/8" Carriage Bolts (3X36) and 1/4-20 Whiz nuts (3X16Z) secure the Partition to the Mounting Plates (See Fig. 14). Hand tighten only.
- B. Also Install one of the supplied carriage bolts (3X36) and nuts (3X16Z) through the upper slot on the adapter bracket and the partition lower mounting tab. (Fig. 15)
- C. Audit the overall installation for fit and function of all components.

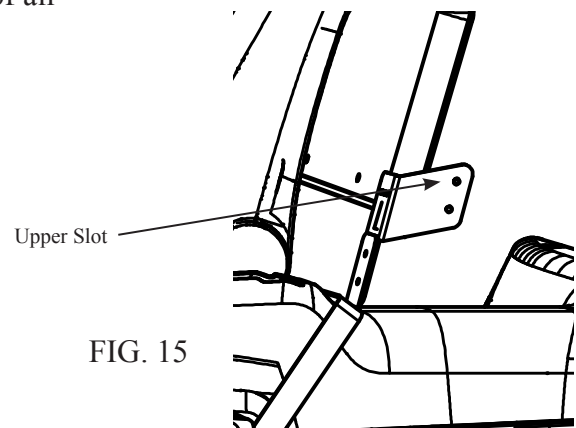
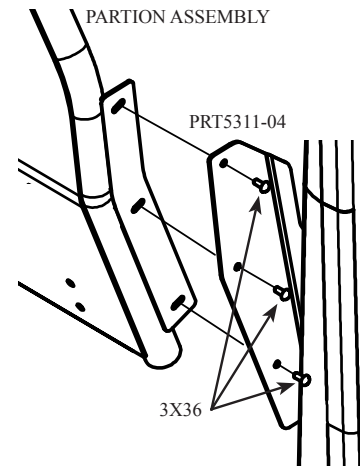

X. Pro-Cell Divider Installation

- A. Assemble vent plate over 3 large diameter air holes. Use (black ABS) spacers between plate and center divider. Secure using the long, Philips head screws, black whiz nuts, and black caps. (See fig. 16)
- B. Insert the center divider from the passenger side of the vehicle. Be sure to start with the tail of the divider, aimed toward the rear window and speaker deck area. Once you have inserted the divider, press the divider against the seat mount brackets, and then to the partition tabs Mark all mounting hole locations on the divider with a felt tip marker then remove the divider for drilling or drill in place if desired.
- C. Once you've installed the divider, mount the divider deck bracket in place. Remove the center child restraint harness loop and take the bolt and stand-off off the loop. Insert the bolt through the 90 deg. bracket and slide the stand-off over the bolt. Reinstall the stand-off, bracket, and bolt into the hole where the loop was removed from. Position the divider tail over the bracket. (See Fig. 17).
- D. Use the existing holes and slots on the bracket as a template, and drill 9/32" holes to secure each area using the 3X61 carriage bolts and the 3X16Z whiz nuts.

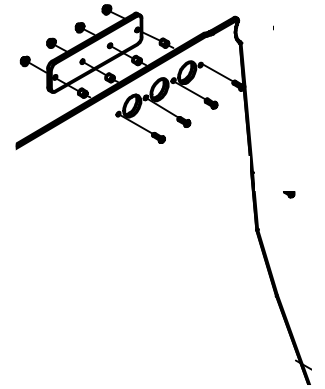
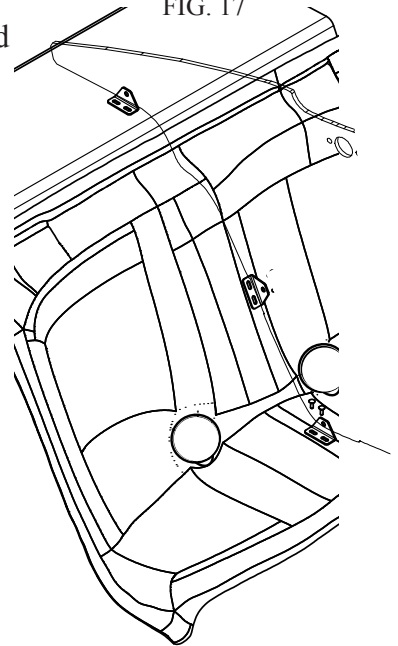

XI. Air Bag wing Installation

- A. The Filler Wings and their mounting hardware are packed in separate box marked Wing Kit. Install the Filler Wings according to thier included Install Instrutions. (See Fig. 18)

XII. Door Panel Instalation.

- A. The Door Panels and their mounting hardware are packed in separate box marked DP5611 . Install the Door Panels according to thier included Install Instrutions. (See Fig. 19)

XIII. Window Barrier Instalation

- A. The Window Barriers and their mounting hardware are packed in separate box marked WB56C11. Install the Window Barriers according to thier included Install Instrutions. (See Fig. 19)

XIV. Finalize Instalation

- A. Audit the overall installation for fit and function of all components. Once satisfied, insure all fasteners are tight.
- B. Instalation is now complete

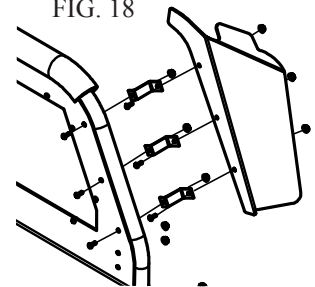
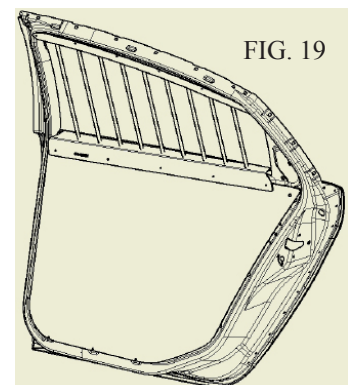
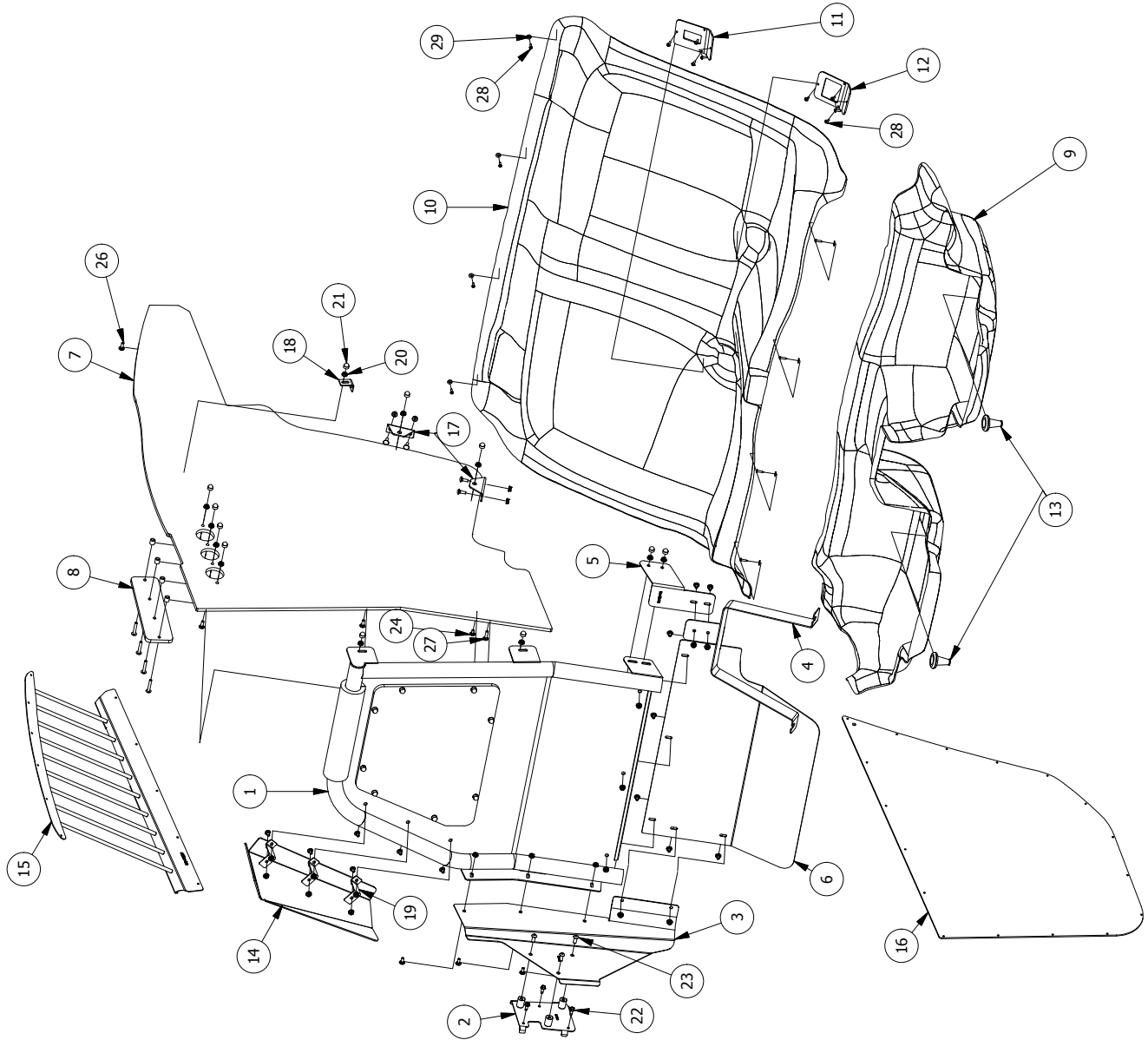
